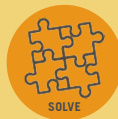

During Challenge weekend, teams are given 14 hours to use the math modeling process to represent, analyze, make predictions about, and provide insight into an open-ended, real-world problem. High schools in the U.S. (including territories and DoDEA) and schools with sixth forms (age 16–19) in England and Wales (including British Schools Overseas) are eligible to participate in M3 Challenge 2025, as are self-formed teams.
